- Basic 1st Aid (Pick One Certificate)
 - American Red Cross: Standard First Aid courses
 - American Heart Association: Heartsaver First Aid
 - ASHI: Basic 1st Aid for First Aid Providers
- CPR (Pick One Certificate)
 - American Red Cross: CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer
 - American Heart Association: BLS Healthcare Provider
 - ASHI: CPR Pro for the Professional Rescuer
